Further in compliance with Article G-1 of Bye Laws of Multiple District 322, I here by appoint nomination committee as furnished here in after.



The nomination committee shall receive nominations for the office of the District Governor and First and Second Vice District Governor for the year 2010-2011 in writing from the clubs sponsoring candidates for the above posts. All nominations in the form of resolutions detailing the qualifications as prescribed in the Bye laws of Constitution of our Multiple District 322 should reach the Chairperson of the Nomination committee at least 7 (seven) clear days prior to the convening date of 19th District Convention scheduled to be held on 13 th and 14th March 2010 at Bhubaneswar.

If there is more than one valid proposals for each post, the Nomination Committee shall recommend to the Election committee for holding of Elections by Secret Ballot as per the provisions of constitution and Bye Laws read together with the constitution and Bye Laws of the Multiple District 322 and of the International Association of Lions Clubs last amended.

The District Governor's election and First and Second Vice District Governor's election shall be conducted by a Secret Written Ballot.

It is the duty of the committee to receive the names of the candidates for the office of the District Governor and First and



Second Vice District Governor and determine whether those candidates are qualified on accordance with the provision of the Constitution and Bye Laws.

The Nomination Committee shall further scrutinized that each candidate is a member in good standing of a duly Chartered Lions Club in good standing in the District at the time of submitting nomination papers to the Nomination Committee as otherwise the Candidate Nomination Paper will be declared invalid. When called upon, the Chairperson of the Nomination Committee reports to the District Conference the names of the candidates qualified for the post of District Governor and First and Second Vice District Governor.

Any member of a club, who fulfills the qualifications as laid down by the Constitution and Bye Laws of the International Association of Lions Clubs and Article G Section 2 District Nominations of Multiple District constitution and Bye Laws as amended upto date, may be elected at the Annual District Convention as a District Governor First Vice District Governor and Second Vice District Governor provided his name is either proposed through a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors of his Home club duly ratified by the members of the said club or failing that he is proposed by the majority of the clubs in district, if the home club proposed a candidates no other clubs shall sponsor such person as a candidate. The proposals shall be sent so as to reach the Chairperson of the Nomination Committee before 7 days (clear). The nomination so received shall be scrutinized by the Nomination Committee appointed by the District Governor and then the same shall be submitted to the District Governor.



EXTRACTS OF CONSTITUTION AND BYE-LAWS OF MULTIPLE DISTRICT 322 IN RESPECT OF NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF DISTRICT GOVERNOR, 1ST VICE DISTRICT GOVERNOR AND 2nd Vice DISTRICT GOVERNOR.

Article G.2 : Any Member of a club, who fulfils the qualification as laid down by the constitution of the Association may be elected at the Annual Convention as a District Governor, 1st Vice District Governor and 2nd Vice District Governor provided his/her name is either proposed through a Resolution adopted by the Board of Directors of his/her Home Club duly ratified by the members of the said club, failing that he/she is proposed by the majority of the Clubs in the District. If the Home Club proposes a candidate no other Club shall sponsor such person as a candidate.

The proposal shall be sent so as to reach the chairperson of the Nomination Committee at least 7 days before the date of the District Convention. The Nomination so received shall be scrutinized by the Nomination Committee appointed by the District Governor and then the same shall be submitted to the District Governor. In the event of no valid proposal for nomination, the nomination shall be invited from the floor of the District Convention and any certified delegate and in absence of the delegate by his/her alternate delegate.

G.2.I. The District Governor election shall be conducted by a Secret Ballot, with the District Governor candidate required to secure a simple majority of the affirmative votes cast by the delegates present and voting in order to be declared elected.



G.2.2. The election of 1st Vice District Governor and 2nd Vice District Governor shall be conducted by Secret Ballot requiring a majority of votes cast by delegates present and voting in order to be declared elected.

G.3.A. candidate for the office of District Governor shall :

G.3.1. Be an active member in good standing of chartered Lions Club in good standing in his/her Single or Sub-District.

G.3.2. Secure the endorsement of his/her club or a majority of the clubs in his/her Single or Sub-District.

G.3.3. Currently be serving as the Vice District Governor within the District from which he/she is to be elected.

G.3.4. Only in the event the current Vice District Governor does not stand for election as District Governor, or if a vacancy in the position of Vice District Governor exists at the time of the District Convention any Club Member who fulfills the qualification for the office of Vice District Governor as set forth in Article GA of this Article G and who is currently serving or who has served I (one) additional year as a member of the District Cabinet, shall fulfill the requirements of Article G.3.3 of this Article.

G.4.0 Any member of a club shall be qualified and eligible for the office of 1st Vice District Governor and 2nd Vice District Governor If-



G 4.1. He/She is an active member in good standing of a Chartered Lions Club in good standing in his/her District.

G.4.2. He/She is either proposed by the Board of Directors of his/her Home Club or failing that he/she is proposed by a majority of the clubs in his/her District.

G 4.3. He/She has served or will have served at the time he/she takes office as 1st Vice District Governor and 2nd Vice District Governor (a) as President of a Lions Club for a full term or major portion thereof and as member of Board of Directors of Lions club for not less than 2 (two) additional years and (b) as Zone Chairperson or Region Chairperson or Cabinet Secretary and/or Treasurer of a full term or major portion thereof and (c) with none of the above being accomplished concurrently.

G. 5. No. member club shall nominate candidates simultaneously for the offices of the District Governor, 1st Vice District Governor and 2nd Vice District Governor in the same election year.

G.6. Sponsoring of a candidate for the office of District Governor, 1st Vice District Governor and 2nd Vice District Governor and any election campaign for the said candidate shall not be permitted earlier than the call of the District Governor for the Annual Convention or 60 days before the date of the Annual Convention whichever is longer. Any member club or Lion member contravening this will be debarred from taking part in the voting and any candidate contravening will be disqualified from contesting the election or from being elected.



G.7. At the District Convention each of the duly nominated candidates for the office of the District Governor, 1st Vice District Governor and 2nd Vice District Governor shall be entitled to address the gathering of the delegates (before the ballot takes place) for 5 minutes and likewise one nominee of each of the duly nominated candidates shall be entitled to speak about his/her candidate before the gathering of the delegates for 5 minutes.

G.8. The Election shall be by secret ballot. The candidate receiving more than 50%+1 affirmative votes shall be declared elected. In case of a tie of any ballot, balloting shall continue on the tie candidates until one is elected.

**EXTRACTS OF CONSTITUTION OF MULTIPLE DISTRICT 322
IN RESPECT TO THE DISTRICT CONVENTION**

(Read with Section 4,5,6 (a b c) of Article IX of Constitution & Bye Laws of The International Association of Lions Clubs)

14.2 Each Chartered Lions Club in the District, who has paid its International, Multiple District and District dues and being in good standing shall be represented by one or more delegates at the Annual Convention and shall be entitled in such Annual Convention to one voting delegate and one alternate delegate for each number of 10 (ten) members of the club (fraction being one half or above to be rounded off to the next higher number) as shown by the records of the office of the Association on the first day of the month last preceding the month during which the Annual



Convention is being held. The selection of each such delegate and alternate delegate shall be made by the Board of Directors of the club and shall be evidenced by a certificate signed by both its President and Secretary or any two other officers specifically so authorized by the Board of Directors of the Club also certifying that they are members in good standing. Each certified delegate, or in his/her absence the alternate delegate present in person may cast one vote only on each issue to be voted on by the delegates to the said Annual Convention. Unless otherwise specified herein, voting on any resolution shall be the act of the Annual Convention.

(Section 4,5,6 (a b c) of Article IX of Constitution & Bye Laws of The International Association of Lions Clubs).

Each chartered club in good standing in the Association and its District, (Single or Sub and Multiple) shall be entitled in each Annual Convention of its District (Single or Sub and Multiple) to (1) one delegate and (1) one alternate for each (10 ten members who have been enrolled for at least one year and a day in the club of said club as shown by the records of the International Office of the first day of the month last preceding that month during which the convention is held, PROVIDED, however, that each such club shall be entitled to at least (1) one delegate and (1) one alternate delegate and FURTHER PROVIDED that each District (Single or Sub-and Multiple) may, by express provision in its respective Constitution and Bye-Laws, grant full delegate status to each Past District Governor who is a member of a club in such



District independent of the club delegate quotas hereinabove specified.

Each certified delegate present in person shall be entitled to cast (1) one vote of his/her choice for each office to be filled by, and (1) one vote of his/her choice on each question submitted to, the respective Convention. The major fraction referred to in this section shall be (5) five or more members. Any club which is newly chartered, and any other chartered club which takes in new members prior to the convening on any other chartered club which takes in new members prior to the convening of any such convention, shall have its delegate quota determined on the basis of members who have been enrolled in the club for at least one year and a day as show on such record date in the records of the International Office. Delinquent dues may be paid and good standing acquired at any time prior to the close of credential certification, as such closing time shall be established by the rules of the respective Convention.

14.3 Delegates or alternate delegates only of clubs which are in good standing will be permitted to participate in the deliberations of the Annual Convention. All other members (not being such Delegates or Alternates) or the clubs shall be entitled to attend (but without voting and/or to the specific rights) the Annual Convention upon payment of fees and charges fixed for such Annual Convention.

14.4 Such fees as the Cabinet may set shall be collected, under



procedure set by the Cabinet from each Delegate, Alternate Delegate, other Lions members and transportation and other incidental charges, if any.

14.5 A number of 50 (fifty) voting Delegates in attendance at the Annual Convention Session shall constitute a quorum.

14.6 An official report of the Annual Convention shall be prepaid and mailed by the Cabinet Secretary to the Association and to all the Clubs in the District within 60 (sixty) days from the date of the close of the Annual Convention.

14.7 All present and Past District Governors shall be entitled to cast one vote on each issue to be voted upon at the Annual Convention. No such Past and Present District Governors shall be included in Delegate quota of his club for any such Annual Convention.

14.8 The Annual Convention may take appropriate actions on all matters in conformity with the Constitution and Bye Laws of the Multiple District and / or the Association.

14.9 The District Governor shall appoint Sergeant-at-Arms and such Assistant Sergeant-at-Arms, as deemed necessary for the Annual Convention.

The function of this committee is to issue credential to delegates attending the District Convention. It certifies the delegates and the alternative delegates from club in good standing in the District and makes written report for transmission to the District Convention in session at the time specified in the District Convention Programme and/or otherwise called for the number of delegates and alternates registered and certified from each club. This certified report of delegates governs the voting at the conference.

In addition to the above voting delegates, voting rights are also conferred on Past District Governors of the District whose clubs are in good standing at the time of Convention. In case the Clubs are not in good standing or in statusquo/ dipute resolution then no credential will be issued to the PDG's. The District Governor has got no authority to clear the statusquo clubs and only International has the authority to declare the statusquo Clubs as good standing clubs after they clear all dues and District Governors submit the reactivation reports to the International.

The District Governor in exercise of the powers vested in his shall fix the time and place for polling and counting of votes during the Convention, if necessary.
